

**Revised Text in lieu of text mentioned at page xxix of Hand Book of Information 2009.**

1. Any student alleged to be involved in any misconduct will be liable to be suspended from the University and on proving the commission of misconduct the student shall be liable to be expelled from the University. The student aggrieved from the decision of the University shall be entitled to appeal to a Standing Committee to be constituted for the purpose by the Vice-Chancellor, of which a retired High Court Judge shall be the Chairman.

2. Once a student has indulged himself in the mis-conduct in any manner whatsoever on the University Campus and action taken against him, he shall not be entitled to admission in any Department of the University and for this purpose a separate web-site be created by the University so that the head of the Department while granting admission is able to check whether the student seeking admission is entitled to admission on account of his previous mis-conduct. The Head of the Department shall ensure checking the web-site before granting admission and shall give a certificate on the admission form to that effect.
