The Vice-Chancellor has ordered to maintain the peace in the Campus, following steps be taken immediately:-

Concerning Vehicles:

1. No student organizations are allowed to organize a rally/car rally/protest without the permission of the Dean Student Welfare, Police Department or Chandigarh Administration.
2. The campus roads are already choked with vehicles parked on both sides of the roads, therefore, no student organization/group of students be allowed to park their vehicles together; more than two vehicles of the same party on the road side. Vehicles should be parked only one side of the road to give sufficient space for smooth flow of the traffic.
3. All authorized vehicles being used on the campus by the students must have valid Panjab University stickers.
4. Only registered vehicles with hostels are allowed to be parked in the parking area of the hostel.
5. Proper checking at the University gates as well as at the entry gates of hostels be done and allow the entry only to bonafide students. Identity Cards be issued to all students latest by August 10, 2012.
6. Vehicles without stickers and deliberately moving at too slow speed to disturb the flow of normal traffic in the campus would be panelised as per traffic rules.

Entry of Outsiders:

7. Movement of outsiders on the campus will be checked and student leaders are also advised to restrain outsiders from involving in university affairs. Roaming and loitering of outsiders in the University Campus be brought in the notice of local police immediately by the Chief of University Security. All students should cooperate in this venture.
8. Chief of University Security to provide the list of leaders of students' organizations and their vehicle numbers to the Police immediately.
9. Chief of University Security be advised to keep a close liaison with the police beat staff of Sector-14 and inform them about day to day happenings at the campus. The information be kept updated with the Secretary to Vice-Chancellor and Dean Student Welfare.
10. Chief of University Security Officer to brief all the security staff to keep watch on each and every activity of students to maintain proper law and order all the time.
11. Chief of University Security to ensure that CCTV Cameras are installed at all the sensitive places and these are in proper working conditions.
12. All types of lethal Weapons including licensed one be strictly prohibited/banned at the University Campus.
13. As and when there is any violence at the Campus, strict action will be taken against the defaulters.
14. Outsiders will not be allowed to campaign during the elections, only bonafide students studying in Panjab University can take part in the election.

15. All the students' organizations are advised not to indulge themselves in defacing buildings/walls/trees, wall/windows of hostel rooms etc., and penalty thereon the Campus, as the same is punishable under the "Defacement Act" or penalized by

the University. The charges for removing these from the buildings/walls/trees etc. be recovered from the concerned Students' Organizations before they are allowed to contest the ensuing Students' Council Election.

16. Printers' name and address should be there on the posters/paper bills, if any, being used by any students' organization, registered with the DSW.

Measures/Suggestions:

17. X.E.N. to ensure that lights on the campus in general and around hostels/ Departments/institutions etc. (Sector-14 & 25) in particular, must be in working condition to ensure proper illumination.
18. Meeting with the representatives of various student organizations be organized for deliberations on violence free during the election by the DSW. Student's organizations be briefed for complying with the recommendations of Lyngdoh Commission in letter and spirit.
19. To keep the check on the expenditure by the students on Election, Financial Observer will be appointed before announcement of the election by the DSW.
20. No group canvassing in hostels/depts. is allowed till the elections are announced.
21. No student can loiter around girl's hostel after 11.00 p.m.
22. Students involved in any violence and creating nuisance on the campus will be dealt with strictly.
23. Students having any problem must first discuss the issue with Warden/Chairperson. In case the issue is not resolved, it may be passed on to DUI or DSW in writing for consideration.
24. Students opting to go on tour/picnic on an invitation of other students will be doing so at their own risk and responsibility and University will not be responsible for any mishappening on this account. Parents are suggested to advise their wards accordingly.
25. Special visits to be conducted by the Wardens/senior faculty member to keep the morale of the students high.
26. Chief University Security should be residential.

Anti Ragging

27. Students are advised to welcome the new students and educate everyone for no ragging. In case any incident is reported/spotted, strictest action will be taken as per rules.
28. Anti Ragging Squad at the University level/different Committees at the level of Departments/Hostels to check the menace of ragging at the Campus.
