The inter-se merit of candidates seeking admission under the NRI category will be based on their score in (i) the Entrance Test (if they are in India) or (ii) SAT –II/ GRE/ GMAT (whichever relevant) and (iii) other scores as applicable. The foreign candidates shall have to comply with visa and other requirements prescribed by the Govt. of India, U.T. Administration, Chandigarh, and Panjab University, Chandigarh as prescribed by them from time to time.

Presence of candidate in the field at appointed time is mandatory. **No separate intimation will be sent.**

d) Roster Form/ list of players duly attested by the competent authority of concerned tournament/championship. The photograph of the player should also be pasted on the certificate duly attested by the competent authority of concerned tournament/ championship.
