If the candidate is not present in India at the time of Entrance Test, then s/he shall be exempted from the Entrance Test. The foreign candidates shall have to comply with visa and other requirements prescribed by the Govt. of India, U.T. Administration, Chandigarh, and Panjab University, Chandigarh as prescribed by them from time to time.
