GENERAL INFORMATION AND NUMBER OF SEATS

The Panjab University will hold an Entrance Test for admission to three year Postgraduate Degree Courses (MD / MS) Junior Residents, for the year-2010 in the Government Medical College & Hospital (GMCH), Sector-32, Chandigarh on **Sunday, February 07, 2010** at **PANJAB UNIVERSITY CAMPUS, CHANDIGARH.**

The total number of seats for admission in the year 2010 are 22, which are divided equally into All India Pool and U.T. Pool as following:

1. **All India Pool (11 Seats):** In compliance of the Supreme Court decision, 50% of total number of seats are reserved for All India Pool.
2. **U.T. Pool (11 Seats):** The 50% of total number of seats are reserved for students who have passed their MBBS examination from Medical Institutions of Union Territory, Chandigarh.

The 14% seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste.

The departments where the single seat is sanctioned by Govt. of India will be put for All India Allocation on alternative year.

The department having two seats shall have 50% All India Allocation of one seat each

The department having three seats will have All India Allocation of two and one seats for every alternative year. Allocation of the 14% reservation for SC (UT Pool) will be made by rotation in alphabetic order of the discipline.

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION

Selection of students for admission shall be made as under:

All India Pool (11 Seats): The screening test for **All India Pool** shall be conducted by All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and candidates will be allocated to the Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh as per their preference in order of merit by the Director General of Health Services, Delhi.

U.T. Pool (11 Seats): The Postgraduate Entrance Examination for U.T. Pool shall be conducted by the Panjab University, Chandigarh as per notification issued by the Chandigarh Administration. The students shall be admitted as per their preference in order of merit in the Entrance Test.

Eligibility conditions for U.T. Pool:

1. The students must have qualified their MBBS examination from Medical Institutions of Union Territory, Chandigarh.
2. Candidate should have completed internship satisfactorily before the last date of application for PG Entrance Examination.
3. However, for MD (Anatomy), Candidates who have worked as demonstrator in Anatomy for one year or more in GMCH are also eligible to apply for MD (Anatomy) only as General Category departmental candidates but they will also have to appear in the Entrance Examination and compete with other candidates.

Important notes:

If a candidate admitted to the course, leaves before completion of full period he / she shall be debarred for next 3 years from applying for admission to any P.G. Course in GMCH. Candidates in employment of Govt. / Semi Govt. / Autonomous bodies / Corporation must submit their application form through their employer or produce 'No Objection Certificate' from / through their employer on or before the last date of receipt of application forms.

MERIT LIST

- i. A candidate has to obtain at least 50% marks (General Category) and 40% marks (SC category) in order to qualify the test,
- ii. If two candidates secure same marks in the Entrance Examination, candidates having higher aggregate marks of all the MBBS examinations passed in first attempt will be preferred. If these two are also similar, then candidate with fewer attempts will be preferred. If the marks in the Entrance Test, the marks in the MBBS examination and the attempts are the same, then the candidate older in age shall rank higher.
- iii. Separate merit list will be prepared for (a) General Category (b) Scheduled Caste and displayed on Notice Board at GMCH Building, Ground Floor, Sector-32/A, Chandigarh & website of the College (gmch.gov.in)
- iv. Choice of discipline will be offered at the time of compulsory personal appearance before the Admission Committee in order of merit in respective categories. There are no marks for the interview. *A candidate who is absent at the time of interview will not be considered for admission.*
- v. Candidates who do not get subject of their choice or could not be selected for any subject can appear at the time of 2nd counselling.
- vi. Unfilled seats will be filled from the wait-listed candidates in the subject of his / her choice in order of merit as determined at the time of second counselling as per their category.
- vii. Seats remaining unfilled from All-India Pool, SC category on account of non-availability of suitable eligible candidates shall be filled from General Category.
- viii. The entire admission process will be closed as per schedule decided by Panjab University and no admission will be entertained thereafter.

PAY AND STIPEND

1. Residency Scheme approved by Govt. of India is applicable to Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh under which selected candidates called Junior Residents will be paid stipend at the following rates or as amended by the Govt. from time to time.

First year	:	Rs. 15,600 per month
Second year	:	Rs. 18,089 per month
Third year	:	Rs. 18,693 per month

2. Fee Payable by the Junior Residents will be as per Punjab pattern (subject to revision of fee by Panjab University Authority) which is as under:

First year	:	Rs.22,000 per annum
Second year	:	Rs.24,500 per annum.
Third year	:	Rs.27,500 per annum

3. In case of surrender of seat, the fees and other funds deposited at the time of admission will be refunded as per instructions issued by the Department / University.

However, other fees, funds and hostel charges payable by the selected candidates shall be separate as per orders issued by Chandigarh Administration from time to time.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Duties and responsibilities of Junior Residents shall be fixed by the Institution from time to time. They will be required to perform such work as may be needed in the legitimate interest of patient care in the hospital.

LEAVE ENTITLEMENT

During the term of employment of the Junior Residents, they will be entitled to following leaves (all kinds of leaves):

First year	:	30 Days
Second year	:	36 Days
Third year	:	36 Days

These leaves cannot be carried forward. Junior Residents are not entitled to any other leave except that mentioned above. Residency as well as examination of residents who avail of the leave over and above their entitlement, will be extended.

ASSESSMENT

At the end of first six months of the admission, each Junior Resident will be assessed by theory and practical evaluation. Besides, there will be periodic assessment during their tenure and logbook maintained.

SUBMISSION OF PROTOCOL AND THESIS

The Junior Residents registered for MD / MS course shall be required to apply for plan of thesis protocol to his / her departmental faculty within 6 months of enrolment and submit it at GMCH (Academic Section), Sector-32 A, Chandigarh. If a candidate fails to submit the thesis protocol within the prescribed period, his / her registration will stand cancelled. The last date for submission of thesis for the students registered for M.D. / M.S. degree will be 6 months before the theory examination.

CONTRACT

Each Junior Resident will be on contract service for a period of three years and will be required to execute a contract bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.10/-. Copy of language of the bond to be executed can be collected from Academic Section of the college. The bond, duly completed in all respects, shall be required to be submitted at the time of joining alongwith Indemnity bond.

Any candidate who opts for confirmed seat in the counseling-cum-interview, his / her original certificates will be retained upto the finalization of the admission schedule. The same will be returned after the completion of the time schedule of admission. The attested photocopies of the complete set of required certificates will also be submitted after confirming the seat at the time of admission.

If any candidate who joins the MD / MS course, leaves the said course before the expiry of one year of joining, he / she shall be liable to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000 (Rs one lac only) and any candidate who joins the PG course and leaves after one year of joining shall be liable to pay a sum of Rs. 2,00,000 (Rs two lacs only) as compensation for losses incurred by the GMCH due to such midstream departure.

GENERAL RULES

1. THE RESULT OF THE ENTRANCE TEST SHALL, IPSO FACTO, NOT ENTITLE A CANDIDATE TO GET ADMISSION IN DEPARTMENT CONCERNED WHERE HE / SHE INTENDS TO SEEK ADMISSION. IT WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CANDIDATE TO MAKE SURE ABOUT HIS / HER ELIGIBILITY AND FULFILMENT OF SUCH OTHER CONDITIONS AS MAY BE PRESCRIBED FOR ADMISSION IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF UNIVERSITY & GMCH, SECTOR-32, CHANDIGARH.
2. **The Entrance Test will be held at PANJAB UNIVERSITY CAMPUS, CHANDIGARH on Sunday, February 07, 2010 at 10.00 a.m.**
3. **A candidate desirous of taking the Entrance Test should ensure that his / her application reaches the *Assistant Registrar, CET CELL, Panjab University, Chandigarh 160014* on or before 15.01.2010 (Friday) up to 4:00 p.m.**
4. **The following documents attached in the given sequence must accompany the application form.**

 - d. Self-addressed envelopes for Admit card & Result Card
5. **Incomplete application forms (in any manner), and those received after 4:00 P.M. on 15.01.2010 shall not be entertained under any circumstances, whatsoever, regardless of the fact whether the application is sent by post or through courier or by any other means. Roll Numbers to such applicants shall not be issued and no correspondence, whatsoever, in this connection shall be made or entertained by the University. 6. IN NO CASE THE COST OF PROSPECTUS FOR THE ENTRANCE TEST INCLUDING THE EXAMINATION FEE, ONCE PAID, SHALL BE REFUNDED.
7. The medium of examination shall be **ENGLISH** only.
8. The candidates shall be required to answer objective type questions on the Answer-Sheet provided for the purpose only, following all the rules / norms as stated on the Answer-Sheet.

9. The candidates shall be required to hand-over the Question Booklet and Answer-Sheet to the Centre Superintendent. No candidate will be permitted to leave the examination hall / room before the expiry of the time allowed for the examination.
10. The candidates shall be required to hand over their answer-sheets and the question papers in full to the Centre Superintendent even if they have not attempted any question. No page / part of the question paper / answer-sheet is to be removed / torn / taken out of the Examination Centre under any circumstances, failing which the candidates shall be disqualified from the test.
11. For rough work, only the sheets marked 'Rough Work' at the end of the question booklet / script be used. No rough work shall be done on the answer-sheet under any circumstances.
12. THE CANDIDATES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO CARRY ANY TELECOMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT SUCH AS PAGER, CELLULAR PHONE, WIRELESS SET ETC. INSIDE THE EXAMINATION HALL. ANY BODY IN POSSESSION OF TELECOMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT WILL MAKE HIMSELF LIABLE FOR EXPULSION.
13. **There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers.**
14. There shall be no re-evaluation / re-checking/re-assessment of answer-sheets.
15. 4-5 days after the test, the question paper and its key will be put on the University website. The candidates can file their objections regarding discrepancies and accuracy of the key, in writing, within 48 hours of this announcement. The valid concerns thus expressed will be given due consideration while evaluation. Within two weeks of the declaration of the result, if a candidate wishes to verify his/her result, he / she will be provided a photocopy of his/her answer sheet on payment of Rs. 10,000/-. In case, a discrepancy is found in the result of the candidate, the result would accordingly be revised and the fee deposited will be refunded.
16. THE CANDIDATE MUST ENSURE THAT THE ANSWERS TO THE QUESTIONS ARE ATTEMPTED ON THE SPECIFICALLY PRESCRIBED ANSWER SHEET ONLY.
17. A Candidate has to obtain at least 50% marks for U.T. Pool (General Category) & 40% marks for U.T. Pool (SC Category) in order to qualify the test.
18. **THE CANDIDATES, WHO QUALIFY THE TEST SHALL HAVE TO APPLY DIRECTLY AND INDEPENDENTLY TO GMCH TO SEEK ADMISSION BY MARCH 10, 2010 UP TO 5.00 P.M. HE / SHE SHOULD SUBMIT THE ADMISSION FORM ALONGWITH ATTESTED PHOTO COPIES OF ALL DOCUMENTS TO GMCH BY DUE DATE. 19. THE CANDIDATE SHOULD BRING ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING.
20. **Any candidate who creates disturbance of any kind during examination or otherwise misbehaves in or around the examination hall or refuses to obey the Superintendent / Deputy Superintendent / Assistant Superintendent / any other official on examination duty or changes his / her seat with any other candidate or occupies any seat, other than the one allotted to him / her shall be expelled from the examination hall.**
("Expulsion" for this purpose would mean cancellation of the Entrance Test)
21. **Any candidate having in his possession or accessible to him / her paper / books or notes which may possibly be of any assistance to him or is found giving or receiving assistance, or copying from any paper / book or note or from anywhere else or allowing any other candidate to copy from his / her answer book or found writing on any other paper, questions set in the question paper, during examination or using or**

attempting to use any other unfair means or indulging in any kind of misconduct shall be expelled from the examination hall.

(“Expulsion” for this purpose would mean cancellation of the Entrance Test)

22. **The Centre Superintendent / Observer / any other authorised University Officer / Official shall be competent to expel a candidate from the examination centre under instruction Nos. 19 & 20.**
23. **If any answer sheet of a candidate shows or it is otherwise established that he / she has received or attempted to receive help from any source in any manner or has given help or attempted to give help to any other candidate in any manner, the relevant answer-sheet shall be cancelled. The cancellation of the answer-sheet shall mean cancellation of the Entrance Test. The decision of the Controller of Examinations (Entrance Test-2010), Panjab University, Chandigarh in this regard shall be final.**
24. **If a candidate writes his / her name or puts any kind of identification mark or discloses his / her identity by any method whatsoever on the cover or anywhere else in the Question Booklet / Answer-Sheet, the same shall be treated as cancelled. The cancellation of the answer-sheet shall mean cancellation of the Entrance Test. The decision of the Controller of Examinations (Entrance Test-2010), Panjab University, Chandigarh in this regard shall be final.**
25. **Any person who impersonates a candidate shall be disqualified from appearing in any University examination for a period of five years including this examination, if that person is a student on the rolls of a recognised College or University. But if the person is not on the rolls of a recognised College or University, he / she shall be declared as a person not fit and proper to be admitted to any examination of the University for a period of 5 years and the case, if necessary, shall also be reported to the police for any further action in the matter. The candidate who is being impersonated shall also be disqualified for a period of five years from appearing in any examination of this University apart from any other action which the University may take against him, as deemed fit.**
26. **If it is found that a candidate has knowingly or wilfully concealed or suppressed any information / fact which renders him / her ineligible to take the Entrance Test, his / her result of the Test as also admission at GMCH, if granted, shall stand cancelled and he / she shall have no claim whatsoever against the University and the case, if necessary shall be reported to the police.**
27. **If a dispute or controversy of any kind arises before, during or after conduct of Entrance Test, the decision of the Controller of Examinations (Entrance Test-2010), Panjab University, in all such cases, shall be final.**
28. **A candidate is required to submit his / her application on the prescribed Application Form, in original. A photocopy or typed copy of the application form for appearing in the Entrance Test shall be summarily rejected and he / she shall not be allowed to take the test under any circumstances, whatsoever.**
29. **THE CANDIDATES SHALL BE ADMITTED TO THE TEST ONLY ON THE PRODUCTION OF THE ADMIT CARD AT THE TEST CENTRE. NO CANDIDATE SHALL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE THE TEST WITHOUT THE ADMIT CARD UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. THE CANDIDATES MUST RETAIN THE ADMIT CARD WITH THEM TILL THE ADMISSION PROCESS IS OVER AND MUST PRODUCE THE SAME AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING.**
30. **ADMIT CARDS WILL BE ISSUED TO THE CANDIDATES ONLY PROVISIONALLY, AT THEIR SOLE RISK AND RESPONSIBILITY SUBJECT TO THE FINAL CONFIRMATION OF THEIR ELIGIBILITY AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION. IT IS FURTHER CLARIFIED THAT THE CANDIDATES SHALL BE TAKING THE TEST AT THEIR OWN RISK AND RESPONSIBILITY AS FAR AS THEIR ELIGIBILITY IS CONCERNED AND THE UNIVERSITY SHALL, IN NO WAY, BE RESPONSIBLE IF THEY ARE FOUND TO BE**

INELIGIBLE, LATER, LEADING TO CANCELLATION OF THEIR RESULT OR ANY OTHER CONSEQUENCE(S) EMANATING FROM THE SAME.

31. **The Admit Cards will be despatched by *January 25, 2010*. In case any candidate does not receive the same, he / she should come personally, alongwith an attested photograph as well as a written request to CET Cell, Panjab University, Chandigarh for obtaining duplicate Admit Card on February 05, 2010 (Friday) upto 4.00 p.m.**

Medical College & Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh and also as enshrined in the P.U. Calendar, Volumes I, II and III (latest editions) and decisions of the University Senate / Syndicate. In case of any conflict or inconsistency between the prospectus on the one hand and the aforesaid Panjab University Rules and Regulations / Guidelines / Hand-Book of information / decisions of Senate / Syndicate & rules of the Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh, on the other, the latter shall prevail.
